Each Father has an Individual Service Plan developed for their personal needs.





- Our Mission

To build a better community by strengthening peoples' relationship skills.

Our Vision

Every child grows up in a healthy family.



How we help:



 Provide access to affordable, effective relationship skills training.



Programs

- **Flourishing Families Program**
 - English and Spanish courses
 - Mostly Parents: single parents, all parenting couples
 - Love Notes for singles classes
- **■** Youth
 - 2014 summerprogram usingRelationship Smarts







- Love Notes (English and Spanish)
- 15 hour classes taught at Family Resource Centers
- Class size 10-30 participants
 - 11% male, 89% female
 - 70% household income less than 20K
 - 70% hold a high school diploma or less and in many cases very little reading ability. (Curriculum & instruction methods work for everyone!)
 - 38% Black, 33% Hispanic, 17% White, 6% Multiracial, 7% other
 - Age: 18% 18-24, 49% 25-34, 33% 35+



- Interactive portions of the curriculum are VERY important – variety of ways to explore the course content
- Emphasize a few key areas try not to speed through too many sections
- Favorites: 3-6-9 rule, Family Patterns, Healthy vs Unhealthy Relationships, Communication Skills, How dating effects your kids
- TIP: pick a few sections/activities, limit lecture, hands on





Recruitment:

RSC regularly recruits at WIC offices, DHA, food banks, community organizations serving families. We receive referrals from over 60 community organizations

Incentives:

On site play care lunch/dinner & snacks gift card when participants graduate Referral to other community resources



- CHALLENGES: Reaching participants & getting them to class
 - Incentives help as do many phone calls, emails, text messages, postcards
 - It takes time and it's helpful to understand the challenges as well as being willing to encourage participants to stay with it

OUTCOMES:

- 87% of graduates report less yelling when arguing
- 91% reported an increase in knowledge of warning signs of dangerous relationship



Love Notes/Dibble



Easy to work with and obtain materials/curriculum
Lovenotes works for a wide range of participants and the hands on activities work for our participants
